



KINDERGARTEN 2023

If your child is born between **1 July 2018 and 30 June 2019** they are eligible to enrol in Kindergarten in 2023. Kindergarten students attend 5 days per fortnight (2 days one week and 3 days the other week), with classes currently attending Monday/Tuesday/alternate Wednesday or alternate Wednesday/Thursday/Friday.

The Application for Enrolment form is available on the Enrolments page. Please complete and return to the school, together with the following supporting documents (photocopies acceptable), prior to **Friday 22 July 2022**:

- Your child's Birth Certificate
- AIR Immunisation History Statement – this is available from Medicare through your online MyGov account and must be dated within 2 months at time of application (you may be asked to provide a newer statement upon acceptance of your application as well, in line with WA legislation)
- Proof of Address – in the form of a utility bill (eg. gas, electric, Council rates notice, rental lease) and must be dated within 2 months at time of application.
- Visa documentation where relevant.

If you reside outside of our local-intake area (please see the map on the Enrolments page), you are still welcome to apply. However, please be aware that you may only apply to **one** WA Public School at any time. If your application to this school is declined, you may not gain enrolment at your local-intake area school. Additionally, if your child is enrolled here for Kindergarten, they are not guaranteed enrolment in Pre-primary. You will be asked to submit an Application for Enrolment for Pre-primary, and acceptance will depend on enrolment numbers at that time.

Applications are assessed after the closing date and offers of enrolment will be sent to families by 12 August 2022.
